## Report on NATIONAL VOTERS' DAY 25 JANUARY 2018



In order to encourage more young voters to take part in the political process, Government of India has decided to celebrate January 25 every year as 'National Voters' Day. It started from January 25, 2011 to mark Commission's foundation day.

It is observed that new voters, who have attained the age of 18 years, are showing less interest in getting enrolled in the electoral rolls, and the level of their enrollment is as low as 20 to 25 per cent in certain cases.
